




Jacob gave Joseph a **gift**. It was a good gift.



But Joseph was not dead. He was in **jai** in Egypt. And he was not alone... God was with Joseph!




**Pharach** was the ruler of Egypt. He had a dream. He wanted to know what the dream meant.




Joseph told Pharaoh that the dream meant there would be a **famine**. They must start saving food.
