After about 7 years as Chair and SAPLC representative on the Shirley House Interfaith Committee I am stepping down and Janet Loughridge kindly volunteered to take over.

We generally hold our own events every month, plus we host Sheffield Interfaith 'Food & Friendship' bring and share dinners most months. Due to Covid-19 events planned for March 2020 onwards were postponed until further notice, with the exception of a well-attended **bring-your-own**, socially distanced picnic in place of the barbecue on 19th July.

- 21st January a former colleague of Gareth's from the University of Birmingham, **Dr** Sharada Sugirtharajah, gave a talk on 'Hindu concepts of God'. This was not a lecture, but an informal opportunity to learn about different traditions and interpretations of the many names of gods in Hinduism.
- 23rd February Rabbi Golomb, from the local orthodox Synagogue, spoke about the Jewish Concept of God.
